CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

We want to make the abstract submission as simple as possible for you. Please prepare your abstract as a word file, up to A4 page size (2.5 margins, Times New Roman 11, single spaced), figures, tables and references can be included within the one page limit, and submit on the conference web page when completing your registration.

Deadline for abstract submission is 15 April 2019. Participants will be notified whether their abstract has been accepted as a standard talk, flashtalk or a poster by 15 May 2019. Unlike at the previous EMAPi conferences, we do not have any a priori defined topics. Participants are invited to submit the results of their work on various topics of current research in biological invasions, ranging from basic science to applied fields, from populations to species to ecosystems, and based on a diversity of methods.

REGISTRATION

The registration is now open at the conference website www.emapi2019.org/registration, where you can find details about rates, discounts and payment method. Deadline for early bird registration is 31 May 2019.

ACCOMMODATION

There are rooms at the student dormitories in the university campus for very reasonable rates, and we also negotiated conference discount for accommodation at the Vienna-Galaxie hotel nearby.
